






WHICH AGE CATEGORY ARE YOU IN?

WHAT IS YOUR ETHNIC GROUP?







WHAT IS YOUR SEXUAL ORIENTATION?





- Prefer not to say 12.29%


DID EITHER OF YOUR PARENTS ATTEND UNIVERSITY BY THE TIME YOU WERE 18?
